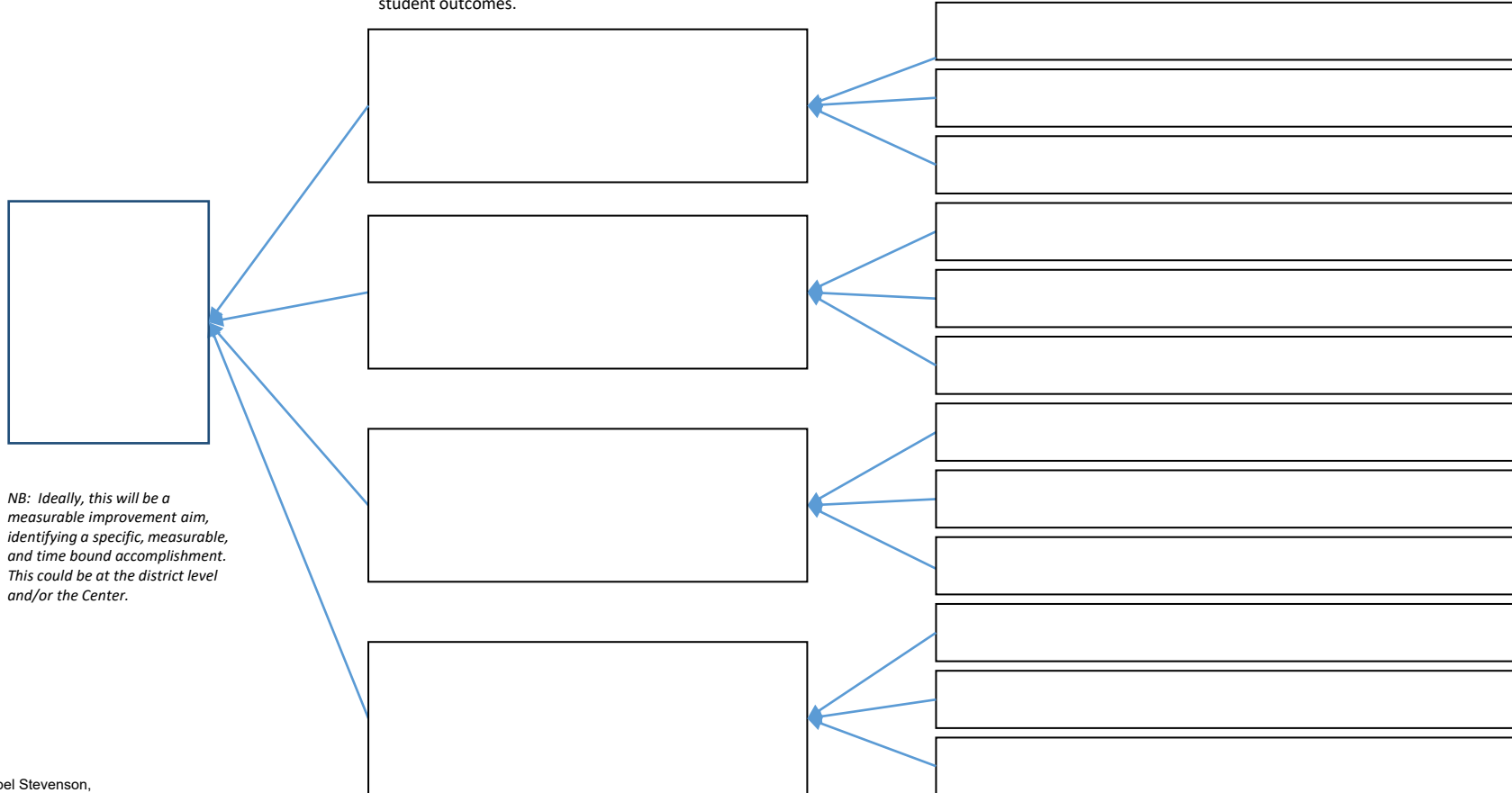


Primary Drivers: A small set of key improvement hypotheses—best initial bets about what to target in the context of the causal system. Each driver represents a hypothesis about a change essential to improving student outcomes.

Secondary Drivers: A set of sub-hypotheses to activate the driver. These are a few drivers that represent key levers for productive change. Some driver diagrams the term “interventions.”



NB: Ideally, this will be a measurable improvement aim, identifying a specific, measurable, and time bound accomplishment. This could be at the district level and/or the Center.
